Dues - \$45, to be paid in November - December for the coming year. **Mailed checks must be postmarked by December 31.**Dues for joining during the year are adjusted as follows: Jan-Mar, dues are: \$45 / April-June: \$35 / July-Sept: \$25 / Oct-Dec: \$15.

Roster - A roster of all members with contact information is maintained by the Membership Chair, which is updated and emailed to all, periodically. Contact the Membership Chair for latest roster and to correct/update your contact info.

Faceboard - Located at the back of the meeting room, this is a helpful tool to learn everyone's name/face and volunteer position. We strive to be a welcoming group of active members.

AWS BOARD - The strength and continuity of this organization is 100% dependent on volunteers who serve on the Board and in other appointed positions. Long-time and recent members are sought to serve on it. The Board includes President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Publicity, Communications (Newsletter/Website), Presidents Emeriti,

two Members-at-Large, and other appointed Committee Chairs, including Hospitality, Welcome, and Nominating. Members of the Board are elected in November to serve the following year, and must have been an AWS member for one year.

- Anyone is welcome to attend Board meetings, which start at 10:30am on the third Thursday of the month.

- This major art show & sale is produced by AWS each year in conjunction with Sebastopol's Apple Blossom Festival, held in April. It takes place in the large rear auditorium of the Sebastopol Center for the Arts.

- There is an entry fee per piece and a size limitation (total entries together must fit within a specified amount of space).
- A professional judge selects Best in Show, Founders' Award, and winners in each media category. The cash awards and ribbons are presented at the following AWS meeting, and a Popular Vote winner is announced.
- A 25% sales commission is retained by AWS on any sales.

Members are eligible to enter the next ABS who have paid their dues and have met the requirements below:

Members who join in Jan – Feb - Mar of the year of the ABS are not eligible to participate that year. NOTE: the December holiday party and June picnic do count for attendance, but not for art work or food.

For the 2026 ABS, requirements are tallied starting in April 2025 and go through March 2026. Updated tallies are listed on the right side of the sign-in clipboards each month. Participation in the production of the ABS is also required. Choosing from a range of committees, participants must complete several volunteer hours to make the show happen, and artists are expected to publicize the show. It is a great opportunity to meet other members and/or step into a leadership role as a committee chair.

- This is a benefit for members to show (and sell) their art work in local restaurants and businesses as a part of our community service. Shows hang for two months (can be four months at the Livery). No commission is taken on sales.
- Members must have attended four meetings within the prior 12-month period to be eligible to show in our venues.

- For years, AWS members have displayed and sold their work at the Gravenstein Fair, which takes place in August in Ragle Park, Sebastopol. There is an entry fee and artists must be present during the two-day event. A 20% sales commission is split between AWS and Farm Trails, sponsor of the Fair.
