

## **AWS VENUES PROGRAM**

AWS' Venues program is in place both to promote individual members as well as in recognition of AWS as a regional artists' group, all while providing a community service for the venue.

Please help us keep all of our venues' walls filled! AWS is in partnership with them all and we want to keep them all happy. It's good for us and it's good for our venues, so let's keep their walls filled with rotating art shows.

If you haven't already, please check out each of our venues to make sure your work is the right fit (size, colors, etc.) and to admire other members' artwork.

Shows are usually for one artist, but if done in partnership, collaborations are always welcome! A Venue signup book is available at all in-person meetings for you to reserve your shows for many months ahead.

### **ROTATION DATES**

Every two months, the day (or week) of the AWS meeting date (i.e. the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month) is the scheduled time to take down the current show and mount the new show. This should be coordinated between the two (or more) artists ahead of time so that the venue wall is empty for the briefest time possible.

### **VENUE GUIDELINES**

- You must visit the venue before signing up so you will know how your pieces will work in the space.
- All work needs to be clean and either framed or gallery wrapped with finished sides.
- All work should be wired properly and securely on the back with a semi-taut wire, about 1/3 of the way down from the top of the frame.
- We want to be respectful of our Venues walls! Never put new nails in without prior approval.
- Each piece should have a small card with your name and contact information, including a phone number, title, and price or "NFS." Attach cards to back of art with tape so it hangs down from lower right corner or side, depending on orientation. DO NOT STICK ID CARDS DIRECTLY ON VENUE WALLS!!

## **AWS VENUES**

Visit the venue FIRST so you know what shape & size art would work best on the various walls. In most Venues, something smaller than 16" wide would be too small. Visit first to know!

**Coffee & Moore** - 6761 Sebastopol Ave. (the old Coffee Katz)  
**[12+ pieces]** *depending on size.* Please try to use the nails already in place

**Fandee's Restaurant** - 7824 Covert Lane @ Hwy 116 (Redwood Credit bldg.)  
**[16 pieces]** Nails cannot be altered. (Rotation between 2-3pm.)

**Specialty Center** - 6880 Palm Ave. (Ophthalmology & Dermatology, across from Art & Soul) **[16-20 pieces]**

**Umpqua Bank** - 201 N Main St. (by Whole Foods)  
**[7 pieces]** Nails cannot be altered.

**Hole in the Wall Restaurant** - 972 Gravenstein Hwy (behind Avid Coffee)  
**[16 pieces]** Nails cannot be altered.

**Hair Masters** - 6980 McKinley Ave. (by Whole Foods)  
**[8-10 pieces]** Nails can be altered. Please check in with AWS Venue coordinator prior to rotation.
